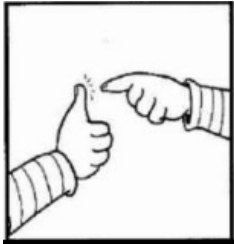


Phonics

Please watch today's phonics lesson - you will need a pencil and a piece of paper. Play Reading Robot on Phonics Play - make sure you select Phase 4



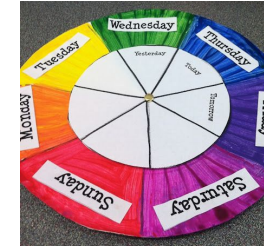
