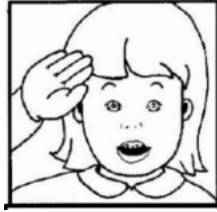


Phonics

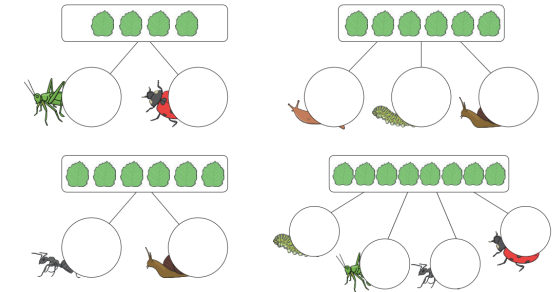
