Pablo Picasso was born in Malaga, Spain. When he was baptized, his name was 23 words long! Pablo Diego José Francisco de Paula Juan Nepomuceno María de Picasso co-founded the Cubist movement. los Remedios Cipriano de la Santisima Trinidad Martyr Patricio Clito Ruiz y Picasso.





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
