The difficulty with large gatherings for a single activity is that social distancing will be challenging to maintain - even if you advise people to keep $2 m$ apart and try to enforce this. In the national social distancing guidance, the Government discourages organisations from holding events where more than 30 people are expected if this can be avoided. We would therefore advise that attendance at any school event should be limited to 30 people (including children, staff and parents).

We appreciate that this will disappoint many of you and we too feel sad that you cannot join us for the afternoon. However, we are investigating ways to be able to share the highlights with you.
